



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Between

Maritime and Port Bureau

Ministry of Transportation and Communications

Republic of China (Taiwan)

and

(1) National Taiwan Ocean University

(2) Sriwijaya University

The Maritime and Port Bureau, Ministry of Transportation and Communications and National Taiwan Ocean University, Taiwan and Sriwijaya University, Indonesia (hereinafter referred to as the "Parties" or individually as the "Party").

ACKNOWLEDGING the readiness of the Parties to develop cooperation in education and research programs of fostering maritime shipping and Port professionals, and to promote exchanges in maritime affairs;

RECOGNIZING mutual competencies and the desire to enhance and develop the cooperation between three Parties based on mutual interest with respect to education and research in maritime affairs;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Parties have agreed as follows:

Article 1

PURPOSE

In order to promote the development of education and research of maritime port and shipping environment, to establish a cooperative relationship by effective use of respective resources of three Parties, and to promote exchanges of practical and academic experiences, the three Parties embody these intentions in this Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter referred to as the "MOU") as the basis for strengthening cooperation.

Article 2

SCOPE AND MODE OF COOPERATION

- a. The Parties should establish contact mechanism for education and research in maritime affairs based on the MoU and MoA between National Taiwan Ocean University and Sriwijaya University signed on November 10th 2015.
- b. The Parties should jointly undertake industry-university cooperative research projects.
- c. The Parties jointly organize academic programs, conferences, seminars and workshops.
- d. The Parties should jointly promote education and research in terms of exchanges of shipping, port management, crew management, maritime affairs, ships, legislation, maritime policy development and international business.

Article 3

OTHERS

The details of the above cooperation of this MoU shall be subject to further consultations between the Parties. The MoU does not affect the rights or obligations of the Parties under the laws and regulations of the respective Governments.

Article 4

COMMENCEMENTS, AMENDMENTS AND TERMINATION


- a. This MoU will come into effect on the date of the signatures by three Parties.
- b. This MoU may be amended or extended by mutual written consent of the Parties.
- c. Either Party may notify the other Party in writing of its intention to terminate this MoU. In that event, this MoU will be terminated six months after the date of delivery of such notice to the other Party.
